# **NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF LEASE AND TITLE ANALYSTS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

## **A. Requirements**

1. Students must have a minimum overall grade point average of 3.0.
2. An official transcript(s), the document that is signed by the learning institution, including the stamp and/or seal of/ or by the registrar, of the applicant's grades shall be provided by the applicant. The applicant may include the transcript(s) with this application or may provide same under a separate cover.
3. Applicants must be enrolled or enrolling in a fully accredited college or university, and do not necessarily have to be attaining an Energy related degree.
4. All applicants must have a sponsor that is a NALTA member in good standing.

## **B. Scholarship Priorities**

1. NALTA Active Member, Honorary Life Member, Associate Member or Retired Member (as described by the NALTA By-laws).
2. NALTA Industry Related Member (as described by the NALTA By-laws).
3. An immediate family member of a NALTA member in good standing (to include but not limited to children, step-children, grandchildren and spouses).
4. An individual not related to a NALTA member pursuing a degree in Energy Management with a member sponsor.
5. All other applicants with a member sponsor.

## **C. Miscellaneous**

1. The NALTA Board is not obligated to award any scholarship during any fiscal year.
2. Scholarship Applications will be accepted from January 1<sup>st</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup> each year.
3. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
4. Scholarships will be awarded to the student(s) after the committee has received confirmation of previous semester grades and enrollment for the present semester.
5. Scholarships granted by the NALTA Board of Directors will be paid directly to the educational institution; however, it will be at the sole discretion of the Board of Directors should they decide to pay the scholarship directly to the student.
6. Scholarship payments are generally made in August.
7. All Scholarship applications should be sent to the Scholarship Committee at the address shown on the Application Form or may be emailed to the current President of the organization to be forwarded

on to the Scholarship Committee.

8. All NALTA Scholarship guidelines must be approved by the NALTA Board of Directors and are subject to change at any time.

9. At the discretion of the Scholarship Committee, candidates may be asked to appear for an interview.

NALTA provides up to \$500.00 for each Chapter to assist their local Members with fees for conferences (excluding the NALTA conference), local seminars, classes, workshops or events for continuing education. The local Chapter will be responsible for the maintenance and distribution of the educational funds in keeping with NALTA guidelines and expectations. Please contact your local Chapter for more information regarding these funds.

Applications will be accepted until April 30, 2017 and must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee co-chairs at the emails listed below.
